- Item #2 The report from the County indicated a balance of \$174,341.74 in the District account on September 30, 2019. District Accountant Samuel noted that checks in the amount of \$30,000.00 have not cleared the account which leaves a balance of \$143.461.37. M.Buzan will check with the Treasurer's office regarding the outstanding checks.. M.A.Moreno moved to accept the report seconded by J.Chism and carried..
- Item #3 **Update** on Bridge Loan Financing for the engineering and certain incidental expenses for the TRSD Phase 1 project, including discussion of negotiations with RCAC and USDA regarding financing -Ongoing, has been elevated to their council attorney.
- Item #4 Status on Vertical Heights de-annexation - All documents are now completed and will be reviewed By F.Rosenfeld, once that happens the petition documents will be taken to Bill Marshall.
