GOOD NEWS ON PROGRESS!!

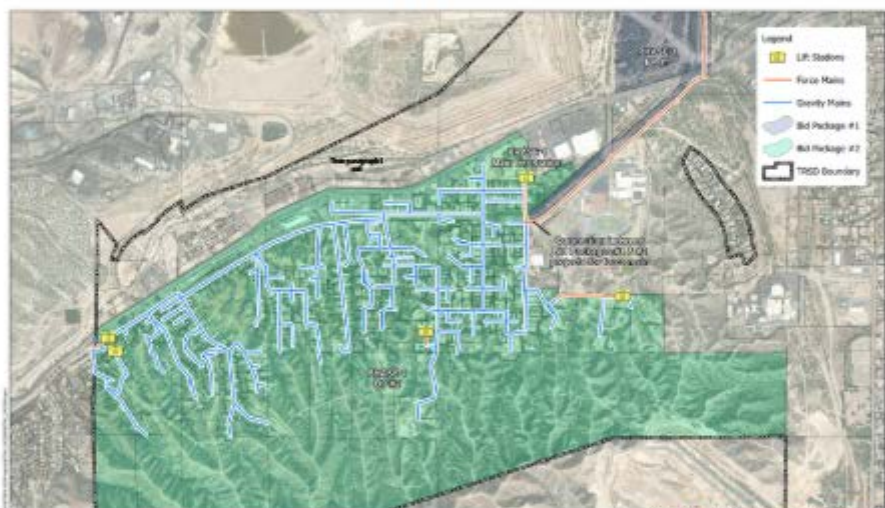
Bids from multiple contractor groups were sent for review with the understanding that all contracts must be reviewed by a committee in Washington, DC, by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). Tri-City Board Members are honored to say we will be breaking ground on the Wastewater Treatment System.

The following construction contracts were awarded: B4 Enterprises for Construction Basins 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, main, and 4 smaller residential lift stations. KE & G Contractors for the WRF site work and sewer main line to the Water Reclamation System. This means actual construction has begun.
